

#### **RECIPE IDEA**

I was fortunate to have had the opportunity to travel to Barcelona, Spain this past Spring, and one of the staples on every restaurant menu was Pan Con Tomate (TomatoBread). I only had to try it once, and I had it every day thereafter!!

You must try it!! Only fresh, ripe tomatoes will do!

# Pan Con Tomate (Spanish Tomato Bread)

A perfect use of ripe summer tomatoes! Pan con Tomate (Spanish Tomato Bread) is an easy Catalan tapa, made with just 5 ingredients: bread, tomatoes, garlic, salt, and a drizzle of olive oil. Use hearty artisan bread and cut it thick so that it can serve as a good, sturdy base for your grated tomatoes.



#### Ingredients:

1 loaf ciabatta bread, or similar hearty bread 3 tomatoes, large and very ripe tomatoes are best Extra virgin olive oil 1 to 2 garlic cloves, sliced in half Sea salt, or kosher salt

#### Instructions:

Slice the bread loaf in half length-wise then in 2-inch slices. Brush the bread generously with extra virgin olive oil and arrange on a sheet pan. Toast in a heated oven about 6 inches from the broiler for 3 minutes or until the bread is lightly golden brown.

Slice a small part at the very tip of the tomatoes and grate the tomatoes over the large holes of a box grater. Discard the peels. Season the tomato puree with salt.

When the bread is ready, rub the garlic cloves over the hot bread, then spread the grated tomatoes over the bread, sprinkle a bit of sea salt and drizzle a little olive oil over it and serve.

#### <u>TIP</u>

After toasting the bread and rubbing the garlic. Cut your ripe tomato in half and rub over the slices, (no need to grate) squeezing the juice from the tomato onto the bread as well, sprinkle with the sea salt and a drizzle of oil and enjoy!




